Friends Ask for Holiday Donations for Hoggle Family and Search Efforts

Search expenses and lost work have impacted family.

Friends and neighbors of Troy Turner, father of missing Montgomery County toddlers Sarah(4) and Jacob Hoggle(2), are asking the community to remember the family during this holiday season. An account set up by the family to support the search at www.FindSarahFindJacob.com has run out of funds. Donations are desperately needed to support the family's search efforts, to help cover income lost due to search efforts, and to help care for the missing children's six-year old brother.

Volunteers will also be set up at the Chick-fil-a parking lot in Germantown this Sunday (December 21st) from 11 AM until 3 PM to receive donations, as well as unwrapped Christmas presents and new clothing suitable for a six year old boy. Any items received that go beyond the needs of the family will be donated to local charities.

The group's goal is to raise \$10,000 to keep the search for Sarah and Jacob funded and support ongoing needs of the family as they deal with repercussions of the ongoing case.

Ed Zacharek, a family friend and retired Montgomery County Detective, said, "Few people could bear this unimaginable burden with the strength and grace we have seen in Troy Turner. As a family friend, I appreciate the support of police and more importantly, the community helping the family during this difficult time."

John Taylor, a Montgomery County private investigator volunteering his services to the family, said, "Troy Turner missed over two months of work looking for his children. It is not hard to imagine how something like this would impact a working family's finances. Yet, Sarah and Jacob are still missing, more flyers must be printed, more acres must be searched, Troy and his family really need the community's help."

Missy Bateman, a long-time family friend and search organizer, says, "The support of the community has been wonderful, but, there have still been thousands of dollars in hard expenses for the family. Flyers, posters, banners, gas, office supplies, water and food for the searchers, it all adds up.
